About the Job

The Kafue Innovation Center is looking for a Research and New Initiatives Intern to assist the Programme team in improving its operations and services. The candidate will provide daily support in managing the centers activities including but not limited to its related social media platforms and/or as well as any additional projects undertaken by the centers team.

S/he will also support research into a wide range of activities and services relating to improving the centers operations, communication strategies, and guidelines that contribute to the efficient running of the innovation center. The candidate is expected to have some knowledge of the technology and innovation in the context of Zambia as well as a working knowledge of web based content management tools.

The internship will primarily be located in the Kafue Innovation Center in Kafue Town, Zambia.

Duties and Responsibilities

The principal duties are to:

- 3. Assist with implementation outreach services with schools in Kafue
- 4. Develop a profile of both income generating and non-income generating activities for center
- 5. Assist in creating a platform for effective community engagement and beneficial activities for community members

- 7. Contribute to drafting of short training curriculum for the center
- 8. Assist with procurement and logistics for centers events
- 9. Contribute in drafting/developing a center charter
