About the role: The Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Manager will provide effective technical guidance and oversight, among other activities, to analyze data on reproductive, maternal, newborn, child and adolescent (RMNCH+A) health outcomes using empirical evidence in rolling out project activities and in making recommendations. The candidate will supervise proposal development, ensuring design and use of program quality standards and cultivating relationships in the field with a view to new and innovative partnerships.

Responsibilities:

- Work closely with strategic partners and externally contracted Technical Support to ensure that high quality and cost effective program are implemented in line with both with national RMNCH+A policies/plans as well as international best practice in the area of RMNCH+A. Key supporting activities for M&E functions include:
- Creating appropriate evaluation tools to determine RMNCH+A program baselines
 - Managing and providing feedback to consultant(s)
 - Disseminating the evaluation results
 - Ensuring that data on indicators is collected, analyzed and presented at the appropriate times to inform decision-making
 - Sharing of monitoring data and other support for the evaluations
 - Initiating the process of reviewing the M&E plan for ayzh on a periodic basis
- Provide technical and programmatic support for operational research aimed at documenting and evaluating key interventions, service delivery approaches and barriers to service delivery
- Help rationalize product development efforts from a clinical perspective

- Expertise in the RMNCH+A sector and quality of care improvement approaches
- Advanced degree in public health, epidemiology, social sciences, health care management or other relevant course of study
- At least 5 years' experience in international public health with preferred experience in RMNCH+A quality improvement programming
